

Dr. Robert H. Schuller:

*Pastor, Speaker,
Motivator, Author*

Dr. Schuller's positive messages are a source of strength and hope, motivating and encouraging people of all nationalities, races, creeds and faiths. He is a pastor, speaker, motivator and author appreciated by countless millions worldwide for his ability to encourage and inspire.

As a **pastor**, Robert Schuller is seen and heard internationally every Sunday on the most widely televised, one-hour church service in the world, the *Hour of Power*, making him the most-watched person on global television. His worldwide audience is estimated at 10 million persons, and he is the first Christian minister in history to be heard every week on American Forces Network, a service of the Armed Forces Radio and Television service, one of the only networks that footprints the globe, reaching 165 countries and all seven continents. His local congregation, in Garden Grove, California, U.S.A., numbers over 10,000 members.

As a **speaker and motivator**, Dr. Schuller is sought for his goal-setting ideas for business conventions and conferences world-wide: Africa, Japan, Korea, South Africa, Switzerland, Norway, Germany, Hong Kong, Australia, The Netherlands, Canada, and throughout the United States.

Dr. Schuller has authored thirty-seven hardcover books, six of which have made the prestigious "New York Times" and "Publishers Weekly" best seller list.

EARLY YEARS

Robert Harold Schuller was born in Alton, Iowa, on September 16, 1926. From the age of four, young Schuller knew that he wanted to be a minister.

He fulfilled that dream in 1950 when he was ordained by the Reformed Church in America after receiving his Bachelor of Arts Degree from Hope College, and a Masters of Divinity from Western Theological Seminary, both in Holland, Michigan. The Reformed Church in America is the oldest Protestant denomination in the United States, with a continuous ministry since 1628.

After ordination, Robert Schuller pastored the Ivanhoe Reformed Church in Chicago for five years. During his ministry there, the congregation grew from 38 to over 400.

MINISTRY ESTABLISHED

In 1955, Robert Schuller was called by the Reformed Church in America to begin a new church in Garden Grove, California. With his wife Arvella as organist, and \$500 in assets, he rented the Orange Drive-In Theater and conducted Sunday services from the tarpapered roof of the snack bar. That first Sunday, 100 persons—all sitting in their cars—attended. Dr. Schuller, who believes this outdoor ministry experience helped inspire him to later build the first-ever, all-glass Crystal Cathedral, often states, "It was there I fell in love with the sky!"

Under Robert Schuller's leadership, the world's first "walk-in-drive-in" church building was designed by Richard Neutra and built in 1961. The fast growth of this young

congregation dictated the decision to build the internationally acclaimed, 2,736-seat Crystal Cathedral, designed by award winning and acclaimed New York architect, Philip Johnson. The glass church was dedicated on September 14, 1980, "To the Glory of Man for the Greater Glory of God."

Today, the Cathedral's ministry is all-encompassing with annual audiences approaching one million people attending events which include worship services, Christmas Eve Candlelight Services, Easter morning services, memorial services, *The Glory of Christmas* and *Easter* productions, conferences, seminars and workshops, interchurch rallies, civic events, baccalaureate and graduation ceremonies.

MINISTRY MILESTONES

In 1968, Dr. Schuller founded New Hope, the world's first live, church-sponsored, Christian 24-hour telephone suicide prevention and counseling center "hot line." Since the beginning of New Hope it is estimated that over one million people have dialed (714) NEW-HOPE for help, any hour of the day or night. Since its origination, New Hope has been a light that never goes out, an eye that never closes, an ear that is never shut and a heart that never grows cold. 1998 marked New Hope's 30th anniversary.

In 1970, Dr. Schuller founded the Robert H. Schuller Institute for Successful Church Leadership, which has more than 20,000 graduates from various Protestant and Catholic denominations.

In 1992, one of Dr. Schuller's lifetime dreams was realized when, through the generous donation of Mr. J. B. Fuqua, of Atlanta, Georgia, the Fuqua International School of Christian Communications was established. Dr. Schuller serves as Chancellor of this interdenominational program which specializes in the art of preaching, where ministers from all over the world study in-depth: the Message, the Messenger, the Method and the Milieu.

In 1997 the church launched an internet website at www.crystalcathedral.org, allowing persons throughout the world to learn about the ministry online, seek pastoral advice, check out upcoming events, and read Dr. Schuller's inspiring messages.

HUSBAND, FATHER, GRANDFATHER

Robert and Arvella Schuller have five children, all of whom are active in Christian ministry. His son, Robert Anthony, is also an ordained minister of the Reformed Church in America. To date there are eighteen grandchildren.

Additional countries include Canada , Australia, New Zealand, the United Kingdom, Holland, Germany, Taiwan, Indonesia, Russia, Lithuania, Latvia, Estonia, Israel, Syria, Jordan, Lebanon, and Iceland each week to an estimated audience approaching 10 million people. It has also been selected by the American Forces Network in the U.S. to be broadcast around the world to cities and bases in over 165 countries. In addition, the *Hour of Power* co-produces special programs twice each year that reach all of India, Bangladesh, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.

May 20-21, Churches Uniting in Global Mission officially adopt Robert Schuller's weekly television program, the *Hour of Power*, as its international television voice.

1991-PRESENT

Elected Chairman of the Board of Churches Uniting in Global Mission, an organization which is an expanding network of pastors of Christian churches from many denominations, uniting to share the positive message of Jesus Christ.

1992-PRESENT

Founded the Robert Schuller International School of Christian Communication, a school specializing in the art of preaching. (Name of School changed to Fuqua International School of Christian Communications in 1997.)

1993

Invited to the Second African/African-American Summit held in Libreville, Gabon, Central West Africa, as the only participant of non-African heritage.

1994

Founded *Hour of Power in Cinema*, presenting the *Hour of Power* on 35-mm film to cinemas in Australia, the United States, Holland and Germany.

1995

Invited by President Clinton to represent the United States as part of the official Presidential Delegation attending Prime Minister Rabin's funeral in Israel.

1996

Invited by Chairman Yasser Arafat to join him and his Cabinet in a private meeting in the Presidential Quarters to discuss their dreams for world peace.

1997

Invited by President Clinton to be his guest at the State of the Union Address.

Speaker at Betty Shabazz' funeral.

With the tendency to group religious broadcast programs into the all-inclusive category of televangelism, each ministry can easily lose its distinct identity. What, then, distinguishes Dr. Robert H. Schuller and the *Hour of Power*?

1.

Dr. Robert H. Schuller is the only mainline Protestant minister whose church services are televised to millions around the world.

2.

Dr. Robert H. Schuller is a member of the oldest Protestant denomination with a continuous ministry in the United States (since 1628)—the Reformed Church in America.

3.

According to television ratings, the *Hour of Power* reaches the greatest number of households and people of all televised church services in the USA.

4.

The *Hour of Power* is the longest-running church service to be seen regularly on the American Armed Forces Network around the world.

5.

Dr. Robert H. Schuller reaches more people, with fewer dollars, than any other televised ministry.

6.

Dr. Robert H. Schuller preaches a positive theology of self-esteem. His goal is to “find a hurt and heal it, find a need and fill it.”

7.

The *Hour of Power* stems from the 10,000-member congregation of the Crystal Cathedral, the church founded by Dr. Robert H. Schuller in 1955.

8.

Dr. Robert H. Schuller does not espouse political views from his theological platform.

Power:**
*Church Service
to the World*

In its thirty-second year on television, the *Hour of Power* (also known as *Robert Schuller from the Crystal Cathedral*) is a one-hour international television program which emanates from the weekly worship services at the Crystal Cathedral in Garden Grove, California.

During each program Dr. Schuller shares his message of positive theology and interviews dynamic individuals whose life experiences exemplify "possibility thinking."

USA VIEWERSHIP

The program first began in 1970 with one station in Los Angeles. Today, the *Hour of Power* is seen throughout the U.S. on 170 broadcast stations and on Trinity Broadcast Network (TBN).

According to the November, 2001, Nielsen Ratings, the *Hour of Power* continues to be the most widely viewed religious program in America.

INTERNATIONAL VIEWERSHIP

Hour of Power worldwide weekly audience is estimated at nearly 10 million persons, and can be seen on all seven continents. The American Forces Network, a service of the Armed Forces Radio and Television broadcast *Hour of Power* in 165 countries. *Hour of Power* major television broadcasts are across Canada, on the Ten Network in Australia, to all German speaking europeans through VOX including Germany, Switzerland, Austria and many other European countries, on RTL-5 in the Netherlands and Belgium, on ATV World in Hong Kong and China/ Pearl River Delta, on ART Network in Russia and several former Soviet Republics, on Sky One in the UK and the Republic of Ireland, on TV-3 in New Zealand, on Omega Television in Iceland, on Channel 38/FIT in Indonesia, on IBC13 in the Philippines, on BMCTV in the Philippines and on METV in Israel, Jordan, Syria and Lebanon and around the world on TBN.

The *Hour of Power* produces a special program at Christmas and Easter for broadcast on India's national channel, in which Dr. Schuller delivers a positive holiday message of hope.

The Christmas Eve Candlelight Service from the Crystal Cathedral is made available to television stations live via satellite. It is aired on television stations worldwide on Christmas eve and Christmas day each year.

STUDIO HEADQUARTERS

The studio for the program is housed within the glass-sheathed Crystal Cathedral. Designed by New York architect, Philip Johnson, the Cathedral provides an inspirational background for the musicians and celebrated guests who participate in the weekly services.

The Crystal Cathedral is the first great church conceived and designed to be a television "super studio" for televised congregational Christian worship.

The *Hour of Power* Communications Center serves as the international headquarters and receives thousands of letters on any given week from friends and supporters of the ministry world wide.

The breathtakingly beautiful Crystal Cathedral structure combines both the intimacy and form of much contemporary architecture with the grandeur and magnificence of medieval cathedrals. It is a concept that had never been tried before in church architecture and heralds a new era of church architectural design. An embodiment of light and space, grandeur and intimacy, the glass structure is recognized the world over as an architectural treasure.

HISTORY

Dr. Robert H. Schuller, recalls, "When the local congregation reached 10,000 and we needed a bigger church building, I remembered how wonderful it had been at my little drive-in church (where the ministry began in 1955) where there had been no walls or ceiling—it was there I fell in love with the sky! And that's why we built the Crystal Cathedral with walls and a roof of glass—crystal-clear glass that lets the sun and sky sparkle through our wonderful sanctuary."

On September 14, 1980, in Garden Grove, CA, Dr. Robert Schuller dedicated the Crystal Cathedral "To the Glory of Man for the Greater Glory of God."

Designed by American Institute of Architects' gold-medal winner, Philip Johnson, with his partner, John Burgee, Johnson has called the Crystal Cathedral his "capo lavoro"...the crowning achievement of his career...a dream fulfilled.

The Crystal Cathedral is also the fulfillment of a dream for Dr. Schuller. Since its opening, the Cathedral has been seen by millions (nearly 30 million per week) around the world via the *Hour of Power* weekly TV program and welcomes thousands of visitors daily, including a congregation of more than 10,000 members.

The Crystal Cathedral is the first great church designed and conceived to be a television "super studio" for televised congregational Christian worship. And, because of the exposure it receives from the *Hour of Power*, it was soon noted by the international architectural community to be one of the most beautiful, and truly creative structures in the world.

BUILDING SPECIFICATIONS

The Crystal Cathedral spans a full 415-feet in length, 207-feet in width and 128-feet in height. The size of the Cathedral is enhanced by the all-glass covering that encloses the entire building. More than 10,000 windows of tempered, silver colored glass are held in place by a lace-like frame of white steel trusses. These 16,000 trusses were specifically fabricated for this engineering feat. The sanctuary seats 2,736 persons including 1,761 seats on the main floor, 346 seats in the East and West Balconies, and 283 in the South Balcony.

Over 1,000 singers and instrumentalists can perform in the 185-foot wide chancel area. The chancel area is constructed of Rosso Alicante marble, quarried in Spain and cut and polished in Italy. The altar table and pulpit are made of granite, and the 17-foot tall wooden cross is antiqued with 18-karat gold leaf.

In addition, two 90-foot tall doors open electronically behind the pulpit to allow the morning sunlight and warm breezes to enhance the worship services held at 9:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. every Sunday morning. The entire service can be viewed on a giant indoor Sony "Jumbotron" television screen which measures 11 1/2' X 15'. The screen, which enables the congregation a close-up view, is the first one of its kind to be used for worship purposes. The service can also be seen on a giant Nit-Star screen directly adjacent to the Cathedral, for "drive-in" worshippers who choose to sit in their cars.

ORGAN

The Cathedral pipe organ, made possible by a gift from the late Hazel Wright of Chicago, is world renowned for its size and quality, and is the largest parish church pipe organ in the world. Conceived by the famed organ virtuoso, Virgil Fox, the organ unites the Aeolian-Skinner organ from Avery Fisher Hall of Lincoln Center in New York City with the Ruffatti organ built for the former sanctuary in 1977.

There have been numerous additions and refinements by noted organ builders. There are 287 ranks of pipes and over 16,000 individual pipes, all playable from two five-manual consoles. White oak cases hold the nearly 11,000 pipes in the chancel area. Included there is a rank of forty-four 32-foot pedal pipes, originally in the organ at Bovard Auditorium at the University of Southern California—a gift of the Mt. Olive Lutheran Church of La Crescenta. The South Balcony divisions of the organ contain 5,000 pipes, and in the East and West Balconies are 549 horizontal trumpet pipes—the largest collection of such pipes in the world.

BALCONIES

Huge, white concrete columns, the largest ever poured, hold the balconies in place. About 10,000 yards of concrete, equal to 20,000 tons, were poured for the foundation of the structure. All visible concrete has a white marbled appearance. The columns are hinged at the balcony, and/or foundation, to permit movement and to withstand an earthquake of the magnitude of 8.0 on the Richter Scale, and wind tunnel tests of 100-miles per hour.

Special facilities in the South Balcony offer simultaneous translation of the worship services into five languages. At present, in addition to English, German, French, Spanish and Korean are offered with special translation for groups upon request.

CONCOURSE

The Cathedral's concourse level accommodates the ever-expanding Music Ministry, including three rehearsal halls, practice rooms and offices for ten choirs, three instrumental groups and hand bell choirs, choir-robing areas, rooms for Christian Education classes, as well as bridal dressing rooms.

Only the lower level of the Cathedral is air conditioned, as the sanctuary itself is

cooled by fresh air flowing from the ground level through clerestory windows which open and close thermostatically. Heat flows from underground pipes to regulate temperature in the cooler months.

BELL TOWER & SPIRE

On the tenth anniversary of the Cathedral, celebrated on September 16, 1990, a beautiful 236-foot Bell Tower was dedicated. One of Orange County's tallest structures, the tower is comprised of highly polished, mirrored quality, stainless steel prisms forming a spectacular spire which catches the light from all directions. This Philip Johnson designed completion of the Crystal Cathedral houses a 52-bell carillon named in honor of Dr. Schuller's wife, Arvella Schuller. At the base of the structure is an intimate prayer chapel named the Mary Hood Chapel. Inscribed above the marble walls of the chapel are the words, "My House Shall Be Called A House of Prayer For All People." The spire has been named the Crean Tower honoring John and Donna Crean who provided a large gift to begin construction in 1988.

To understand the successful accomplishments of Dr. Robert H. Schuller, founder of the Crystal Cathedral and worldwide television ministry, you must also recognize the role of Arvella Schuller, the other half of the Schuller team.

As one of seven children growing up in the Iowa farming community of northwest Iowa, Arvella has been an integral component of her husband's international ministry since their marriage in 1950. In 1955, she utilized her childhood training in classical and sacred music as organist of the drive-in church the Schullers founded and conducted from the top of the snack bar at the local drive-in theater.

Over the years since, Arvella Schuller has proved herself to be a determined woman who takes seriously her role of wife, mother and grandmother, and is an accomplished professional in her own right.

"HOUR OF POWER" PRODUCER

Since its inception in 1970, Arvella Schuller has served as Executive Producer and Program Director for the Hour of Power worldwide television ministry. Dr. Schuller refers to his wife as "the architect of the Hour of Power," as she creatively blends traditional worship with advanced broadcasting, electronic, satellite and computer technology. In recent months, under Mrs. Schuller's guidance, the Crystal Cathedral has gone "high tech" and "on-line" with its own worldwide web site on the Internet.

CHURCH SERVICE ORGANIZER

Many of the successful church programs organized in the early days by Arvella Schuller have become institutions and long-anticipated annual events at the Crystal Cathedral. People around the world and across the USA crowd the Cathedral to worship at one of the seven Christmas Eve services and Easter Morning services, which are detailed and orchestrated under the careful supervision of Arvella Schuller. The Christmas Eve Services are transmitted by satellite to T.V. stations across the country and around the world, seen by untold millions of people worldwide.

PROGRAM DEVELOPER

The Crystal Cathedral ministry often reflects the "fast-forward" vision of Arvella Schuller. She is credited with the early development of the 24-hour New Hope Counseling Center; Helping Hands, a food and clothing service for the underprivileged; The Crystal Cathedral Pre-School; and the Crystal Cathedral's Literacy Center, affiliated with the Laubach Literacy Center.

In 1976, Arvella Schuller created the Crystal Cathedral Academy, a private school for kindergarten through 12th grade, with special emphasis on music and fine arts. The Arvella Schuller Music Scholarship, which was established in 1993, developed into The Arvella Schuller Scholarship Fund by 1996, an endowment to continue financial aid to Crystal Cathedral Academy families.

Arvella serves on the Board of Trustees of Crystal Cathedral Ministries and its Women's Ministry. Over 30 years ago, she started the Women's Ministry which offers many programs and support groups for women in all stages of life, and large events such as The International Possibility Thinking Women's Conference and Day Extraordinaire, attracting thousands of women to the Cathedral each year.

MUSICIAN & ORGANIST

At the dedication of the 14,000 pipe Crystal Cathedral organ, Arvella Schuller was credited with inspiring the vision of the organ and being a main participant in its eventual installation. Nearly a decade later, the spectacular Arvella Schuller Carillon (featuring 52 bells cast in The Netherlands), was dedicated on the main campus of the Crystal Cathedral.

She also has a 2,987 pipe organ dedicated in her honor at Christ Chapel, Northwestern College, Orange City, Iowa, where donations poured in from the Friends of Arvella Schuller Committee.

AUTHOR

An accomplished author, Arvella Schuller won the Religion in Media Book Award as author of *The Positive Family*. She has also authored *Mommy is Better Than a Blanket* and co-authored, with her husband, *The Courage of Carol*.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

Arvella Schuller has been equally active in community service throughout Orange County, California. Volunteer service here has included the Orange County Burn Center, the Mary Magdalene Project (a special ministry for young prostitutes) as well as the YWCA Home for Homeless Women.

In 1977, Arvella Schuller was one of 12 women nominated, from over 2 million Orange County citizens, for the Athena Award for outstanding community service, presented by the Central Orange County Panhellenic Association.

A cancer survivor, Arvella Schuller has sponsored annual Reach to Recovery Benefit Luncheons for the American Cancer Society, raising thousands of dollars for breast cancer research.

AWARDS & RECOGNITIONS

Awards abound, each recognizing Arvella Schuller's accomplishments throughout the world. In early 1997, Arvella Schuller received the Hollywood-based Excellence in Media Board of Directors' highest honor, The Gold Angel Award. It exemplifies the finest lifetime achievement award by media peers nationwide, for productions judged to be the very best in ethical, moral and social impact.

Schuller, Senior and Founding Pastor, officially opened the International Center for Possibility Thinking by world-renowned architect Richard Meier on May 18, 2003.

PROPERTY ACQUISITION

Back in 1957, when young Pastor Schuller was first shown the property on the corner of Chapman Ave. and Lewis St. in Garden Grove, CA, 40 acres were available for purchase. At that time the ministry was only able to finance 10 acres on which the original sanctuary was built. Over the years, 23 more acres were acquired as the ministry added the Tower of Hope, the Crystal Cathedral sanctuary, the Robert H. Schuller Family Life Center, and the Memorial Gardens cemetery. Crystal Cathedral Ministries has purchased the final 7 acres and a striking four-story, 58,000 square foot center of clear glass and an all stainless steel exterior has been completed.

ADDITIONAL PARKING & ENLARGED LAWN

Hundreds of desperately needed parking spaces have been added to ensure that each on-campus experience is a positive one for an ever-increasing number of church members and visitors. One of the ministry's long-range goals is to add lawn and playground space for children attending Sunday School and the Crystal Cathedral Academy, as well as for large group gatherings. Plans also include enhancing the lawn and garden area "framing" the architecturally beautiful Crystal Cathedral building and within the Memorial Gardens cemetery.

INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR POSSIBILITY THINKING

This new, world-class 58,000 square foot structure, designed by the renowned architect, Richard Meier, will benefit congregant and visitor alike. The building was the first structure ever designed to "preach a life-affirming, dream-building, possibility thinking sermon." It includes:

- A spacious and elegant lobby, open to the lovely California breezes, to welcome members and visitors throughout the week and on Sundays.
- A giant screen Performing Arts Center to tell the story of this great church and inspire viewers, including thousands of ministers attending training sessions on campus, to build their dreams, too.
- The Robert Schuller and Crystal Cathedral Archive and a "Museum that Motivates" will offer a living, continually updated history of the ministry.
