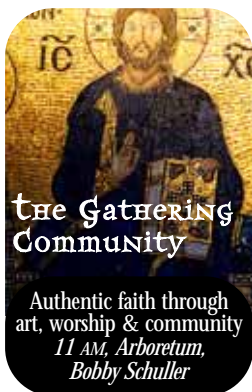

Help Illuminate our Children's Dreams!

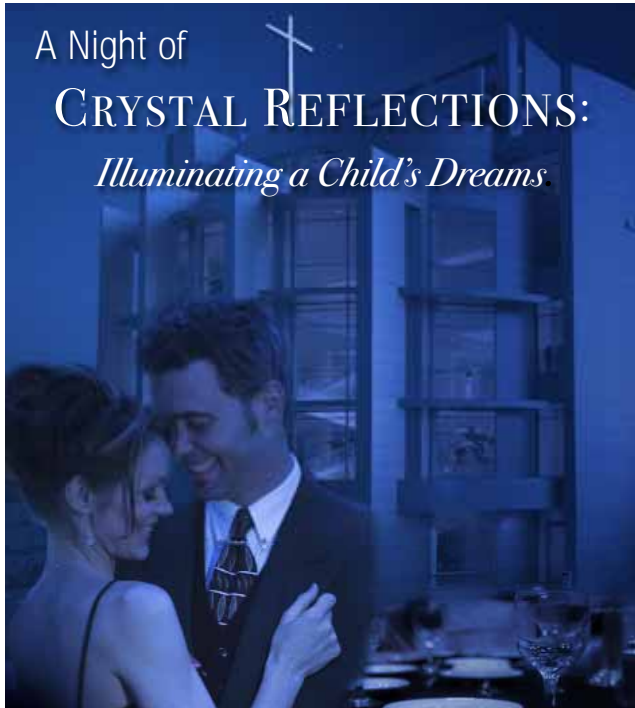

Message from our Senior Pastor

Walk in Your Own Shoes and Discover God's Direction for Your Life

As I prepared to succeed my father as Senior Pastor of the Crystal Cathedral, on more than one occasion someone said to me, "You've got some mighty big shoes to fill, Robert." The truth is I could never fill my father's shoes: He wears a size 10 1/2 and I wear a size 12!

I knew what they meant, of course. But I also knew I would never fill my father's shoes spiritually or figuratively any more than I could physically because I'm a different person than he is.

In Ephesians 2:10, Paul tells us: "For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." Once God made each of us to walk our unique paths in our own shoes, He threw away the mold.

James Taylor & Sons began making fine shoes for London's best-dressed citizens in 1857. Soon these shoes were being ordered by European royalty. The present manager of the shop is a fifth generation Taylor.

Taylor's shoemakers travel anywhere in the world to ensure that the shoes delivered may be worn for decades to come. But the process doesn't

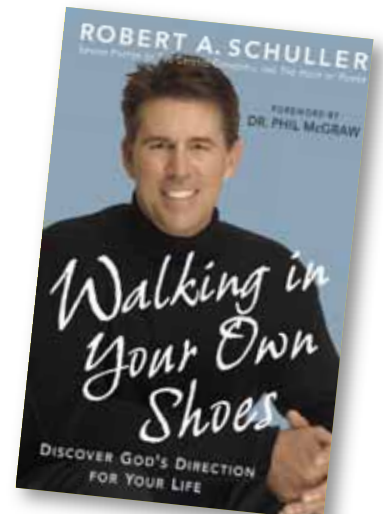

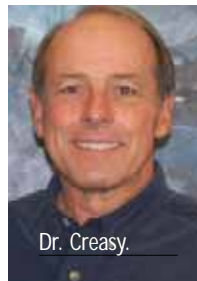

Fall Series Begins: Luke & Acts

Have you always thought about undertaking an in-depth Bible study, but just haven't made that commitment? Well, this is the time to start and this is the class for you! On Monday, September 17, 7 – 9 PM in the Freed Theater, we will begin the fall quarter of The Bible Plain and Simple with a study of the New Testament books of Luke and Acts.

The Gospel of Luke presents a detailed, histor-

ical account of the life of Jesus Christ. Luke, the great physician, presents with great accuracy and clarity the life of Jesus, who broke down religious, cultural, social, and economic barriers - a Jesus who constantly laid down His life as the Son of God to reach out to sinful man.

Continuing on in the Book of Acts, Luke further gives us an account of the events surrounding the growth of the early church. In Acts, we first learn of the Apostle Paul and his evangelistic trips where he planted and nourished many new churches. It is here where we learn how the Holy Spirit transformed a small band of praying believers into a worldwide church that is fulfilling Jesus' great call to preach the gospel to the entire world.

Each Monday night throughout the academic year, almost 300 people attend this truly ecumenical Bible study taught by teacher extraordinaire, Dr. Bill Creasy, whose lively and animated style of teaching brings the Bible to life like never before. It is lecture style, and there is no homework! Just bring a Bible, and come and listen!

The Bible Plain and Simple is a systematic, verse-by-verse, expository study of the entire Bible, Genesis through Revelation, consisting of weekly two-hour lectures; written introductions, notes, outlines and bibliographies for each book of the Bible; and color satellite maps, timelines and photographs. Dr. Creasy's deep knowledge of the ancient literature, languages, history, and culture of the Bible, his love for the Scriptures, his dynamic teaching style, and his remarkable sense of humor bring the Bible to life as never before.

You can begin this series of classes at any time and catch up on any lectures you may have

New Hope Counselors are the most humble, gracious, and generous people you could meet.

Each time I've called one of our volunteers to say that we want to recognize him or her as our "Counselor of the Month," I get a similar response: "Really? Oh, I don't deserve that. I'm just doing God's work. You don't need to give me an award. Can you give it to someone else?"

This is the demeanor of this month's recipient and so I hesitate to share her name! I want to protect her private prayer closet in which she serves Christ on the New Hope phones and does so out of love for Him and for the callers who are hurting; she doesn't serve for any recognition she could get. However, I want to give you the blessing of getting to know this New Hope Angel.

Angela Russell grew up in Maryland watching the *Hour of Power* with her grandmother. Many years later, her dream of visiting the beautiful Crystal Cathedral campus came true when she relocated to Southern California! She works in Beverly Hills as a health care human resources manager and attends the Crystal Cathedral. One Sunday she learned that New Hope was training new counselors, so she decided to register despite her busy schedule and long commute.

Angela didn't miss a class! She said, "During my training, I met Susie Balk and Reverend Jim Kok, who became my mentors and re-confirmed my commitment to become a New Hope counselor. I also recall how therapeutic the small group training sessions were. And, how these sessions allowed me to get rid of past issues in my life that I didn't know existed, which was amazing to me."

It takes a village to train a New Hope counselor! And so Angela credits her learning and growth, not only Susie Balk (former director of training for New Hope) and Pastor Jim Kok, but also to the New Hope staff, her telephone trainers Carol Womer and Norm Reiber, and the "very special individuals" that make up the Sunday team of counselors with whom she serves.

"It's hard for me to comprehend that I've been a New Hope Counselor for nearly 10 years," Angela told me. "But, I can truly feel what a difference being at New Hope and being connected to the Crystal Cathedral has made in my life... It's a feeling of being so close to God."

In addition to volunteering as a counselor, Angela serves as a New Hope trainer. She explains,

"I always encourage the trainees to do their best, not to compare themselves to other counselors, and to let God work through them while they are on the phones." And, she urges them not to worry about challenging calls because, "God gives you the calls that you need."

The Family Counseling Center continues its counseling support effort to reflect our mission serving families and individuals during the life challenges of pre-marital, marital, family, career, and everyday coping issues.
