

Tanzania, East Africa
“Full Dimension Ministry”
Mission Trip
(Information Sheet)

Full Dimension Ministry is a non-profit, tax-exempt, non-denominational faith based organization dedicated to spreading God’s word through mission activities that reach the impoverished Tribal Groups in Tanzania, East Africa. As a result of this outreach, thousands are receiving desperately needed medical care through its clinic in Yulansoni village within the Iramba Valley, and Tanzanian children are receiving secular and Christian education though it’s pre-school. Plans are also underway for the development of a deep well for clean water at the clinic, and sunflower seed oil press as a village business with profit going toward clinic expenses. FDM is led by Pastor William Makali, who completed his Master of Divinity at Erskine Theological Seminary in South Carolina, and who returned to his native land of Tanzania to begin this mission in 1995. When: Potential Date for trip is October 6-16, 2008 (tentative)
(Note: It is also possible to extend your stay, and custom arrangements can be made with advance notice and request.)

Cost: The cost of this trip is presently estimated to be under \$2000 per person, plus round-trip airfare to Tanzania. This price includes lodging, food, several cultural site tours and ground transportation. Participants will be required to purchase and book their own airline reservations and this should be done in consultation with the program coordinator.

Volunteer Opportunities: Small teams will be working with pre-school children, assisting in the medical clinic, and working on small construction jobs.

Accommodations: Teams traveling to Tanzania can expect to stay in a simple guesthouse or hotel with two persons to a room with twin beds. Toilets and baths are inside rooms. In most cases, breakfast and dinner will be provided and lunch will be taken on site.

Additional Information: Travel to Africa may require special immunizations, and if you are interested in participating in this project, you are asked to contact your physician regarding your physical fitness to travel. Your physician will recommend the inoculations you need for your health and for the country or countries you plan to visit.
