## FAMILY ASK DR. BILL

### MY FRIEND LIED

*Q: I was falsely accused of some terrible things by a close, Christian friend from church and he has never apologized for what he did. I've spent many days in prayer, looking to forgive, and seeking God's wisdom and comfort over this, but I still feel forsaken by him. When I saw him the other day, I could not speak. Can you give me any suggestions on how to heal this hurt?*

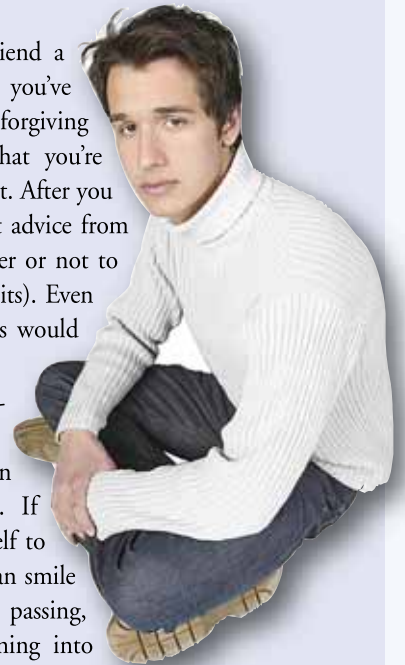
A: I understand that you feel betrayed by your friend. And now, when you see him, you also feel hurt, angry, and anxious. You don't want to feel this, and yet, working through these feelings is part of the emotional healing you seek. Here are two options for how you could deal with your hurt:

1. Set up a meeting with him and your pastor to go over the issue together and to offer your forgiveness.

2. Or write your friend a letter, telling him how you've been hurt, that you're forgiving him, and specifying what you're asking him to do about it. After you write the letter, then get advice from your pastor as to whether or not to send it (perhaps with edits). Even if you don't send it, this would still be healing for you.

If he becomes apologetic and shows compassion then perhaps you can renew your friendship. If not, then prepare yourself to forgive anyway. If you can smile and say "hi" to him in passing, then you can face running into him without fear and your freedom to worship freely and joyfully at church will be restored.

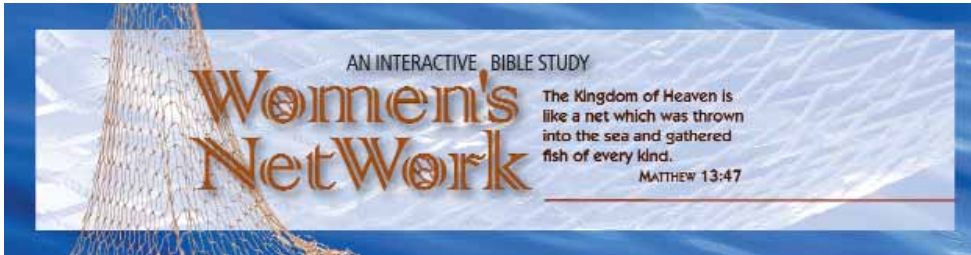

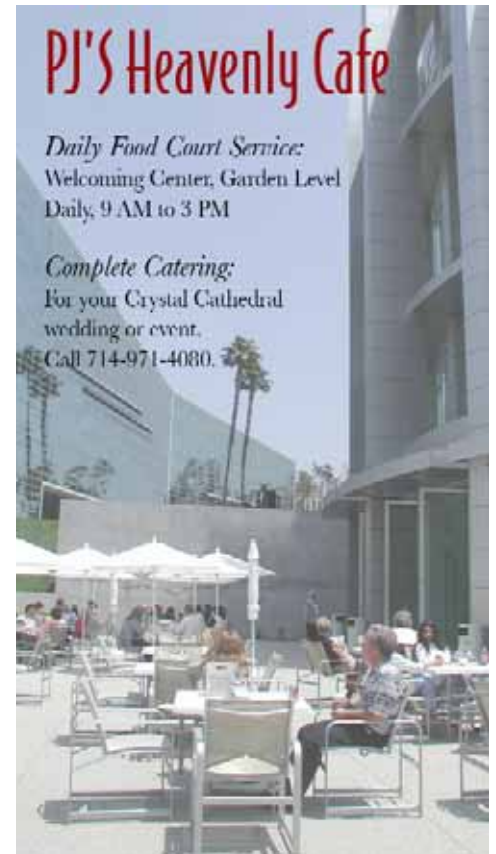

the land where Jesus Christ walked. His presence and purpose touched people whose lives were forever changed, just as mine has been by “walking where Jesus walked.”

Over the past several months as I was writing my latest book, *Walking in Your Own Shoes* (Ed. Note: Now a bestseller; see sidebar), I did a great deal of thinking about what it means to walk in your own shoes. Walking in your own shoes is really about having the courage and faith to BE all that God created you to be, and to DO all that God has called you to do. It's about living life on purpose, and living life with purpose.

As I re-visited the age-old town of Bethlehem, walked by the Sea of Galilee, traveled the road to Jericho, reflected at Golgotha, and stood overlooking the city of Jerusalem – a city Jesus “wept” over – it struck me: Who better than Jesus under-

stands what it means to walk in your own shoes?

Walking in your own shoes is about doing the right thing. Remember Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane: “Father, if you are willing, please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine” (Luke 22:42, NLT). Jesus always did the right thing. And that's what we're called to do, too – to have the courage to do the right thing.

Sometimes, walking in your own shoes means facing challenges, frustrations, and pain. It's never going to be a perfectly smooth road. But in the end as you “walk in your own shoes” and become all that God intends you to be, and do all that He's planned for you to do (Psalm 139:16), you will experience true joy and blessing in your life.

As you celebrate Jesus' birth this Christmas, may you find renewed strength, courage and faith to walk in your own shoes. Your possibilities are endless!

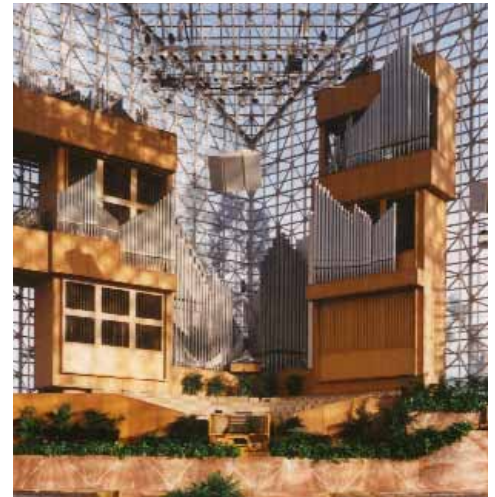
## February Concert Announced

Good Friday service at the Crystal Cathedral, they were immediately hooked. They joined in 1968, and Wendell testifies to the major contribution this ministry made to his life. "It changed me," he

states, "and Helen, too. As we met happy people, we became nicer, too. I started to be able to be friendly to folks I previously couldn't stand," Wendell declared. Not only that, he said he started getting pay raises at work. "I just became un-self-centered," he said. "It was the preaching and the happy friendliness." And, as Wendell and Helen deepened through this ministry, they found even more blessings as they committed themselves to tithing.

country in the U.S. Coast Guard. His duty was confined to Southern California around Newport Beach and San Pedro. It was relatively peaceful except for one vicious storm that practically blew their boat apart. But his hearty disposition kept him laughing even then and, other than a couple of serious injuries, he reflects

that he's never been sick. He doesn't even catch the flu!

The church is Wendell's life, with a secondary hobby of being a revered Pottawattamie Indian. His son, a retired M.D., is the Director of the Pottawattamie Nation in Northwestern U.S. There are small benefits, like subsidized pharmaceuticals and assistance with some medical appliances, but the main thing is

enjoying an identity where he is truly regarded as one of their treasured people. We want Wendell to know there is a second place here at the Crystal Cathedral where he is greatly treasured, too. Wendell also knows how much Jesus loves him and he still exudes the happiness that began so long ago.

Women's Network (the women of the church and community who meet on Tuesday mornings at 9 AM in the Art Gallery) decided to reach out to the community during the holiday season. One of the group's members, Susie Nass (a lady on a mission full of compassion), felt that the group could help a family in need at Christmastime. Her idea, "Let's clean off our bookshelves. We can trade our unwanted books and make a donation for the ones we want to take home!"

On a Tuesday morning in October, more than 500 books were brought in and, during the 20-minute "coffee break," 65 women raised \$252. The four bags of leftover soft-covered books were donated to the Prison Ministry at the Cathedral and two boxes of hardback books went to a local library.

With the recent devastating fires that ravaged through Orange County and the surrounding counties, Susie felt that the funds raised should go to a family who lost so much during this recent travesty. Then she heard about a young mother who has had a recurrence of cancer and who could use some financial assistance. So Susie came up with another brilliant idea: "Let's bring our old unwanted jewelry and do the same thing!" On the second Tuesday in November, the Women's Network group brought in more than 1,000 pieces of jewelry and raised \$495! A grand total of \$747 will be donated to this needy family.

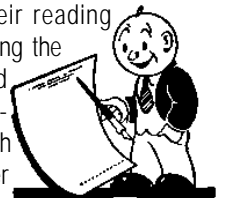
