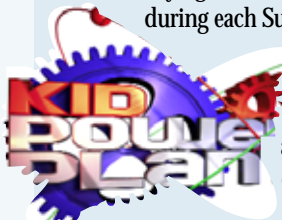

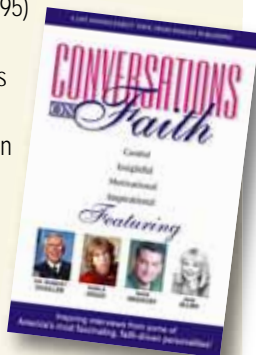

Finding a Need and Filling It

Revealing the Heart of the Crystal Cathedral

Last Friday while Nancy, Susan, and I were volunteering as greeters and tour guides, Nancy met a young man who told her that he had recently been released from prison. He said that, while imprisoned, a fellow inmate told him that his only way to find joy in life was to accept Jesus. He was told that when he returned to Orange County, he should join a Christian fellowship group. He is now connected with a group that is composed of many ex-felons, Victory Outreach.

Friday morning he had been to the courthouse in Orange and, seeing the Tower of Hope in the distance, remembered that the man in prison also told him that he had parents who went to the Crystal Cathedral. So, after the court visit, he walked over to see what the Crystal Cathedral was like.

Nancy introduced him to Susan who took him on a tour. During the tour, Susan found out that he

was in a Bible study group, but that he did not have a Bible. So, after her tour ended, Susan brought him to me just as I was preparing to take about 25 other people on a tour.


I asked these visitors to excuse me for a few minutes, went into our Crystal Cathedral Books and Gifts, and bought the young man a nice, new study Bible. He didn't realize that I had done that, so, when I came out of the store and gave him the Bible, he broke into tears, embraced me in a big bear hug, and thanked me profusely. Kind of made me teary, too. When I told our visitors the story of what was going on, many of them got weepy, as well, especially when they saw him walking away with tears in his eyes and a smile on his face.

As my tour ended, one of the visitors told me that he, like the others, came to see the Crystal Cathedral buildings and grounds, but that this group was especially blessed because they also got to see the Crystal Cathedral's heart.

Arabic-speaking Christian Americans. Some of them have been gathering together for almost six years in fellowship under the leadership of Pastor Emeel Shenoda. "Our congregation - that is made up of those originally from Syria, Palestine, Iraq, Lebanon, and Egypt - feels so deeply blessed that in America we are able to freely express our faith in Jesus Christ."

Pastor Shenoda and his congregation have, most recently, been meeting at Orange County Worship Center in Santa Ana on Friday and Saturday evenings, but have been seeking a location for Sunday services and Sunday school for the children. When the pastor realized that the Crystal

It is a great honor to be given the privilege to worship and reach out to the thousands of Arab people living in the surrounding area through the Crystal Cathedral. As I say this one month before we begin our services there, I feel I am, and we are, already related to the Crystal Cathedral family."
